RE: Actions of Steering Committee since last Board meeting

The Steering Committee has been delegated the authority by the Board of Directors to take action on time critical and administrative items.

In keeping with the policy approved by the Board for delegating authority to the Steering committee, the following item was approved by the Steering Committee with the requirement that the Board be informed at their next meeting. Governing Board members can ask for review and possible reconsideration of the item at the Board meeting.

Re: AB 361 (Rivas) dealing with extending the Brown Act changes due to the pandemic would allow local government to continue to have virtual, hybrid or in person meetings. The SBCCOG had a position of monitoring the bill. The legislature has approved the bill and sent it to the Governor for his signature. On September 13, the Steering Committee took the following action to approve:

- Changing the SBCCOG position to SUPPORT and directing the staff to send a letter to the Governor asking him to sign the bill.
