



#### **Success Story:**

- Matilda, Veteran
- Homeless for 10 months in Torrance and Long Beach areas
- PATH connected her to VASH voucher, helped her locate an apartment in Torrance
- She is successfully paying bills, attending VA groups, occupational therapy, mental health appointments, and enjoys her regular home visits with PATH case manager

## **South Bay Travel Pal**

- Travel Pal is a free, web-based, trip-planning tool.
- Participants discover route, health and environmental information for different travel modes: Walking, Bicycling, Transit, Driving and Carpooling.
- Through incentives, logging and social media, participants are encouraged to make smart mobility choices that will lead to: health benefits (calories burned); reduction of local congestion; and, positive impacts in local Green House Gas emissions.
- Travel Pal is being tested for event and work and school trips.



- Coordinate with League of California Cities






