1. Self-Introductions and Approval of February 14, 2018 Meeting Notes – Chair Stephanie Katsouleas called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm. The February 14, 2018 meeting notes were received and filed.

II. Agency & Other Reports

SBCCOG: Jacki Bacharach gave the following updates:

- 2018 General Assembly: The GA was well received with over 300 individuals attending.
- Regional Bike Share: There is a discussion going on regarding potential coordination of local jurisdictions' response to all of the various bike share programs popping up and trying to start in cities in the South Bay, such as LimeBike, Metro's Bike Share, etc.
- Trenching Meeting: At the request of SoCalGas, the SBCCOG convened a meeting of city representatives and utilities to discuss coordination of trenching on public ROW and city requests for the utilities to lay fiber or provide conduit for it. Through the IWG, the SBCCOG will work with cities to create a proposed South Bay Dig Once program and present a draft to the utilities.
- Board of Directors meeting: The Board will be approving the Measure M Public Participation Plan. There
 will be a presentation on climate change by a UCLA professor. The SBCCOG Board will also be taking a
 tour of the LA BioMed campus in May.
- South Bay Traffic Forum, LA County DPW: Robert Torres provided an update on the status of the County's ITS projects, which include the South Bay CCTV & Fiber Project (completed), Centracs System for Cities of Carson and Hawthorne, and IEN for Cities of Torrance and Redondo Beach. Mr. Torres also provided updates on the Traffic Signal Synchronization Program Projects. Caltrans: Jimmy Shih gave a brief update on Caltrans' projects. Mr. Shih reported that I-110/I-405 auxiliary lane construction contract is to be awarded in April 2018. The I-405/Crenshaw Blvd project is currently in design and Caltrans has been coordinating with the City of Torrance. This project is expected to be ready to list for construction bids in March 2020. Mr. Shih noted that the I-405 North/Artesia Blvd project is complete as well as the I-110 South/PCH project.

L. A. Metro Updates

 L.A. Metro Board – Mark Dierking announced that there will be tours of the Metro Gold Line for South Bay elected officials, city staff, city commissioners and community members in the vicinity of the alignment alternatives to get a first-hand look at what the Green Line extension to Torrance might look like as it passes through the South Bay communities of Lawndale, Redondo Beach, and Torrance. Now that the guidelines are completed, the PAC may shift its focus the Metro Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) update. There is discussion as to whether the PAC should be dissolved as a Metro Board advisory committee and/or restructured as to its purpose and membership.

Steve Lantz gave a presentation on the development process for the Measure M Multi-Year Subregional Programs (MSPs).
