For this reason, representatives from the HERO Program will come to our office on February 5th to give us an orientation on the Program, discuss the launch, and answer any questions we may have. They have also graciously offered to provide us with lunch, which will be available starting at 12:30pm. The meeting will begin at 1pm and will last 60 to 90 minutes depending, on the level of discussion.

For those of you who are not familiar with the HERO Program, it is the largest energy efficient financing program in the nation. Through a partnership with our municipalities, they offer low interest, tax deductible financing to property owners who make energy efficient upgrades to their homes.

More than 150,000 products qualify for financing through the HERO Program, including whole-home heating and cooling (HVAC), solar power panel installations, energy-saving windows, roofing, and insulation, among other types of energy and water efficient improvements.
