HOMELESS INITIATIVE

As we all know, the incidence of homelessness throughout Los Angeles County is increasing. In this context, on August 17, 2015, with unanimous support of the Board of Supervisors, I launched the Homeless Initiative within the County's Chief Executive Office. The initial goal of this initiative is to develop a coordinated set of recommended County strategies to reduce homelessness for consideration by the Board of Supervisors in February 2016.

To develop these recommended strategies, the Homeless Initiative will conduct an intensive, inclusive planning process. From October 1, 2015 to December 3, 2015, there will be 18 policy summits, two summits on each of nine topics. The policy summits will bring together: County Department representatives; city representatives; the Veterans Administration; and invited community stakeholders and experts. I would like to invite your city to participate in whichever policy summits are of interest to you.

The policy summits will address the following topics:

- Affordable Care Act Opportunities
- Coordination/Integration of Current Services and "No Wrong Door"
- Discharges into Homelessness
- Employment
- Encampments/Street Homelessness/ Outreach and Engagement
- Homelessness Prevention
- Land Use
- Subsidized Housing
- Supplemental Security Income/Veterans Benefits Advocacy
