




# How Did Cierra Become a Part of the SBCCOG Team?

-In 2016, I became a success story for both the COG as well as the SBWIB due to receiving full time employment as an Administrative Assistant.



Misty Torres, 33, of Redondo Beach, had worked as a phlebotomist for the past nine years and was laid off in 2015. Without a job or immediate prospects, Ms. Torres was struggling to make ends meet. Mother of two, her situation became more challenging when she gained temporary custody of her sister's two children. With four children to care for, Ms. Torres was more eager and motivated than ever to find a good paying job with insurance benefits.

Ms. Torres came into the Torrance One-Stop ready to find employment. Upon meeting with the case manager, Ms. Torres found she was eligible for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act (WIOA) Adult Program. The One-Stop immediately assisted her in updating her resume which highlighted all the work experience and skills she had accumulated within her nine years of employment.

With a fresh resume, Ms. Torres began applying for the positions presented to her by the Torrance One-Stop. Ms. Torres was offered a position as Laboratory Technician doing phlebotomy work at St. John's Hospital. She negotiated her pay to \$24 hourly and was given an excellent health package.

#### Cierra Washington, Torrance

Cierra Washington, 30, of Torrance, is a mother of a twoyear-old son. She had been working for Crossfire Marketing Group, a company that contracted with IGS Energy. When Crossfire lost its contract with IGS Energy, Ms. Washington found herself unemployed. With a young child at home, Ms. Washington knew she had no time to waste in finding another job to sustain both her and her son.

Ms. Washington remembered the assistance she received from




**Torrance Turf Removal Class** 

- I correspond with the South Bay Environmental Services Center's Utility partners to receive their latest marketing materials and fun giveaways, that we share at different events in your cities.
- For Example: The SBESC staff and I educate the South Bay constituents on the So Cal Gas Companies, Energy Efficiency Kit Cards, which includes 3 faucets, aerators and a low flow shower head, that uses less water pressure, thus allowing our constituents to save energy and money on their gas bill.
- I also track the distribution of the EE Kit Cards collected per month, which is captured in the SBESC Monthly Report.

- As part of the outreach team, I share fun posters from our partners with students. I get to talk to them about land fills, germs and how to properly get rid of waste to ensure that we teach them early how to preserve the environment.
- I also register participants for Rain Barrel Distributions, as well as all the free classes brought to the constituents by the City of Torrance and West Basin.
