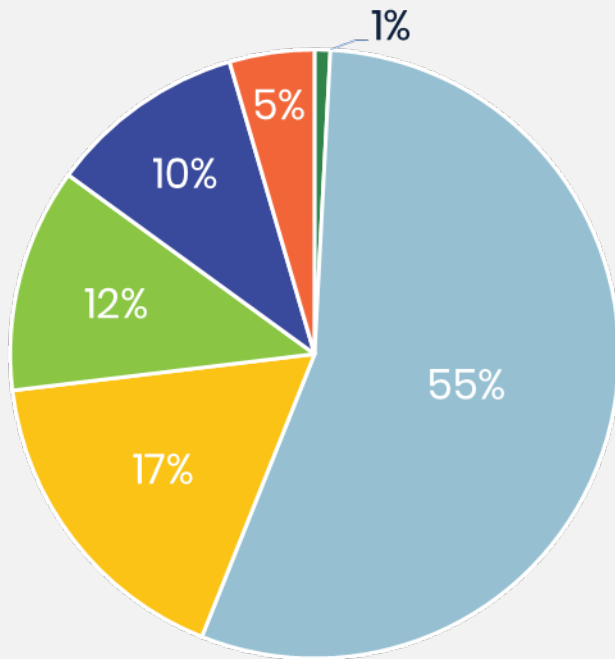

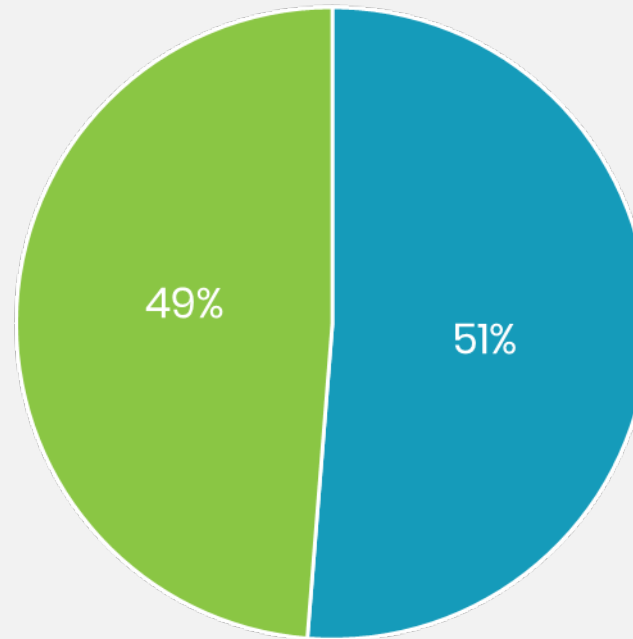


Households by County, 2016



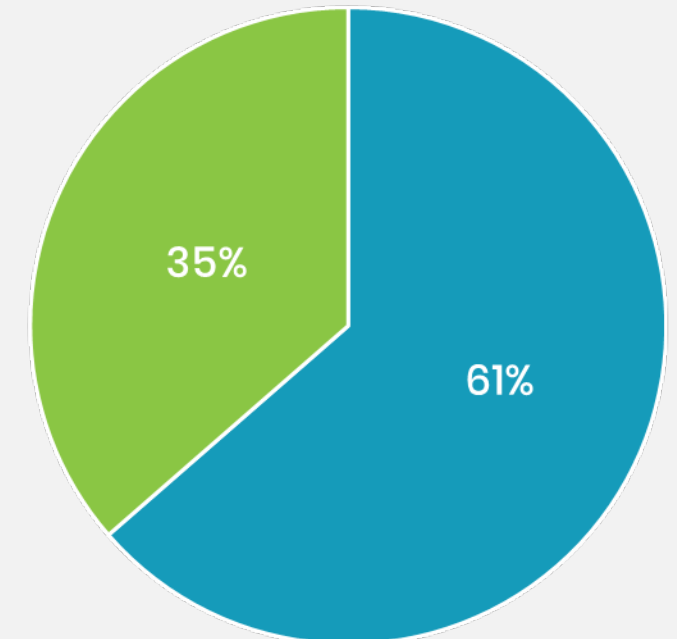

# President's Special Committee on Equity

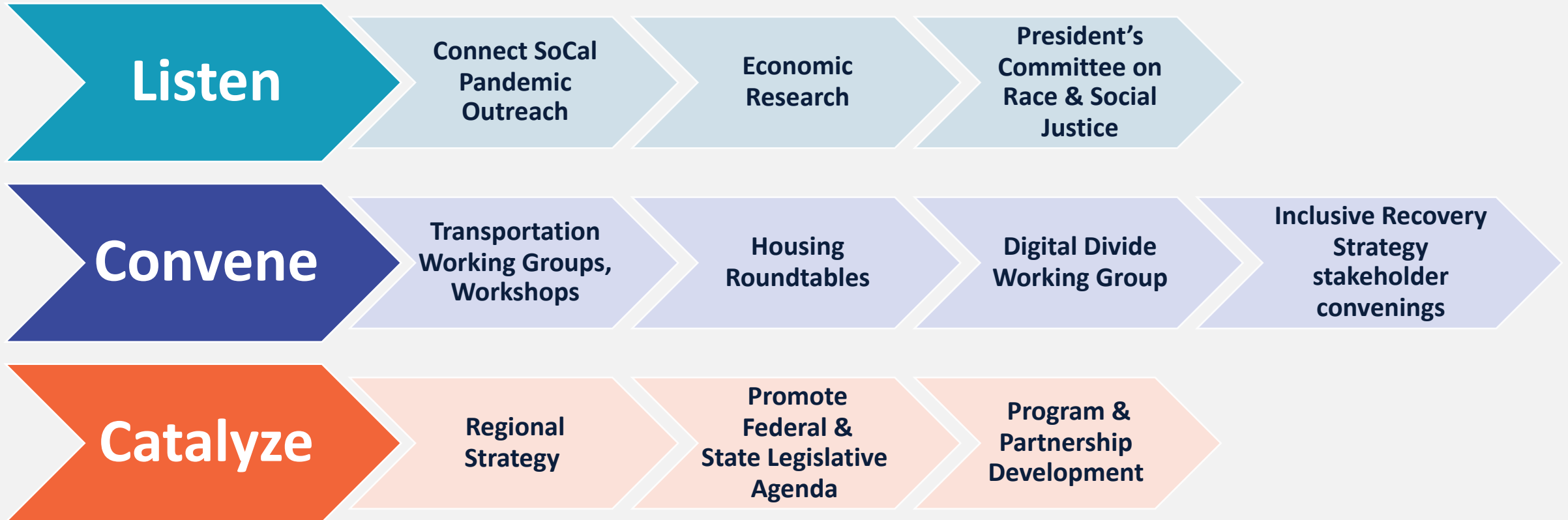
In July 2020, SCAG's Regional Council made a commitment to advancing justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion throughout Southern California.

SCAG has developed:

- A working definition of equity;
- An equity inventory of current and potential equity-related work activities; and
- An equity framework, containing documentation of historic policies and practices contributing to inequitable outcomes; indicators of existing inequities; and recommendations for future actions.



# Regional Economic Recovery Strategy





- SCAG Call for Collaboration – *Due February 23, 2021*
  - Open now
  - Equitable housing strategies for non-profit organizations:
    - Partnership Programs: Up to \$125,000 to support existing plans, initiatives, and/or partnerships
    - Spark Grants: Smaller, capacity-building grants of around \$50,000 to seed new models of collaboration

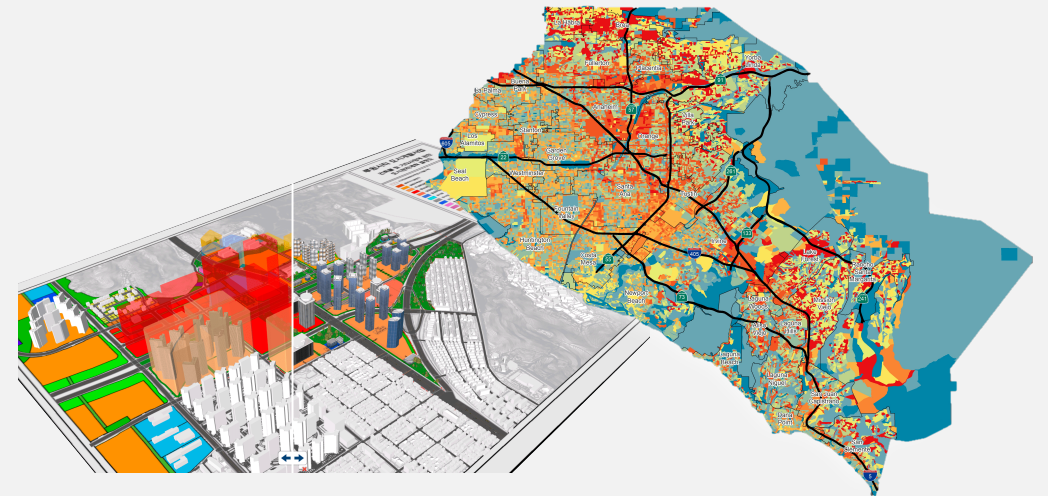
