


10/22 Metro Report

K Line (Crenshaw/LAX) Opened October 7th

Currently averaging approximately 2,000 riders per day



Fareless System Initiative and Low-Income Fare is Easy

(LIFE) Pilot programs were successful, Metro is now looking for permanent funding sources. Program ends June 30, 2023.

- 79 school districts & 8 Community College districts participating
- 1 million TAP cards distributed





End of Line Policy and Unhoused Riders Motion

Metro staff is developing a policy to address riders remaining on trains at the end of the line.



Metro Tree Policy Adopted

The Board adopted a policy that:

- Protects trees through the planning, design, construction phases, as well as maintenance.
- Replaces any trees required to be removed for projects at a 2:1 or 4:1 ratio.
- Maximizes the use of native species, carbon capture, urban heat effect mitigation, stormwater capture, and use of recycled water for irrigation.
