









Education & Workforce Training

AltaSea education activities are primarily focused on building capacity for Ocean and Earth STEM education & workforce opportunities for underserved and minority students.

- Integration of marine sciences (including aquaculture) in early education curriculum via *AltaSea* Ocean Pathways and Expand LA core science education for LAUSD students.
- Hands-on aquaculture experiences through after school programs and workshops with established partners including Boys & Girls Club, Sea Grant, Port of LA schools and more.
- Expanded in-depth aquaculture experiences including PACE training program for 10-12th graders and internships with regional organizations through *AltaSea* Ocean Pathways.
- Pipeline to PACE workforce training program and job opportunities, higher education, and institutional research partners.
