
- County-wide, web-based portal

Community Connections (continued)

- **Gardena Joint Outreach** Between PATH Outreach, Harbor Interfaith, LAHSA, and Mental Health America at two locations in proximity of each other have been identified as areas of concerns and constant follow-ups (Dominguez Channel and 190th & Normandie).
- **Department of Public Health and PATH** with assistance of Sera Collections Mobile Team have established a relationship to better assist individuals who are experiencing homelessness and might not have easy knowledge or access to Covid and/or Monkey Pox Vaccines. Monday 10/31/22 was first joint outreach together
- **Carson Joint Outreach** between PATH Outreach, Harbor Interfaith, and Carson Sheriff Department to identify areas of concern around the city. Sheriffs have also continued to provide support to PATH Outreach when needed.
- **Lawndale** City officials and PATH worked together for joint outreach efforts to identify individuals experiencing homelessness within the city. City staff continue to provide support when needed.

Exit Strategies

- Direct Placements
- Shared Housing
- SRO living facilities
- Recuperative Care
- Interim Housing with Case Management

Challenges

- Staffing (Only a team of 2)
- Shelters at their max capacity and/or covid lock-down/quarantine
 - Lack of interim housing availability
- Low affordable housing availability, especially for seniors
 - Street 2 Subsidy has no more availability
 - Emergency Housing Vouchers have been paused indefinitely



Success Story

Mr. CJ began experiencing housing uncertainty after the home where he was living caught on fire. The PATH Outreach Team came into contact with Mr CJ after being referred by Ivan from Janice Hahn's Office and began the housing search. In September, Mr CJ was approved for a unit in the city of San Pedro. With the assistance of Client Aid for the Security Deposit and First month's rent, the participant was successfully housed in a unit Mr CJ has expressed he finally feels at home again

Success Story

PATH Outreach Team was able to obtain placement at Westhaven Affordable Apartments for three participants. The three participants are from Carson, Redondo Beach, and Wilmington. Official placement is to take place sometime in November (opening date still pending), however, all have had their intake documentation completed. All three participants have stated their excitement and gratitude towards the case managers who have helped them get to this point.
