- Will create a Peer Respite Group Home for folks recovering from behavioral health issues.
- 124 awardees throughout the state. 1 of 35 in LA County
- We partnered to provide matching funds using our Measure H allocation. (\$110k – coming out of the SHARE budget)

Last System Did Not Work for Cities –

- System was not responsive to our needs
- Old Model: Funding to LA County > LAHSA > Non-Profits
- New Model: County Funding > Eligible Jurisdictions > Non-Profits
- City shelters not consistently funded
- No data
- Wrong doors, silo'd systems, poorly managed LAHSA shelters, wrong mix of outreach workers and case managers.....

Immigration Enforcement Impact on Homelessness

- Anecdotally, we generally do not get a lot of undocumented requests for service
- We received our first Client Aid request last week from a mother of 4 who was too scared to work and therefore not able to pay her rent.
 - Worried there is more to come
